Procedures for G.I. Bill eligibility certifications

- 1** Complete the Veterans Online Application (VONAPP) at vabenefits.vba.va.gov/vonapp
- 2** Apply for admission to UC Clermont College at ucclermont.edu/admissions/apply
- 3** Confirm your Degree Program and Major at onestop.uc.edu
- 4** Prepare for Out-of-Pocket Expenses
 - Please allow 4–6 weeks for processing
 - University payment plans are available
 - Complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) at fafsa.gov
(Receipt of VA education benefits does not necessarily exclude you from additional financial aid funding)
 - You may be eligible to receive additional benefits, such as the Ohio National Guard Scholarship (ONG-SP), Fry Scholarship, Ohio War Orphan Scholarship, Ohio Safety Officers College Memorial Fund, or unit Tuition Assistance
- 5** Complete the Questionnaire
- 6** Read and review the Orientation Presentation
- 7** Work with a UC Academic Advisor to select appropriate courses
- 8** Complete the Veterans Programs & Services benefits form
(every fall semester or any time you change programs)
- 9** Check your eligibility for Ohio in-state tuition through the **Ohio G.I. Promise** and apply if appropriate

Veterans and Military students are eligible to receive an admission fee waiver and Priority Registration. This is not available to CH33 TEB or CH35 DEA benefit recipients.
