This program is for those considering a career in real estate. The four basic areas required by the Ohio Division of Real Estate are offered in a three-course program designed to prepare students to take the real estate sales exam. These current, state-of-the-art courses were developed in consultation with professionals and experts in the real estate business.

Students successfully completing the courses earn the 120 classroom hours required by the Ohio Division of Real Estate and acquire nine college credit hours through the University of Cincinnati Clermont College.
